Welcome to Respect!

Respect is The Football Association's programme to address unacceptable behaviour in football – on and off the pitch. On average, 7,000 referees quit football every year because of the abuse they receive from players and from the sidelines. Lots of children also pack it in because of the attitude and actions of over-enthusiastic and pushy parents.



One of the tools that the F. A. has brought in to help eradicate poor behaviour are various codes of conduct, these are aimed at players, coaches / managers, parents / spectators, club officials and match officials to ensure that they behave in such a way to show **RESPECT** towards each other. The codes of conduct are shown below for players and parents / spectators:

Codes of Conduct

Waveney Youth F. C. were awarded the 2007 F. A. National Charter Standard Community Club of the year award, one of the criteria which the club were judged on, was that the policies and procedures we put in place ensured that our young players enjoyed their football in a safe and enjoyable environment and also the parents / spectators behaved in a sporting and well behaved manner. Having set the benchmark as the country's top junior football team, it is very important for us to maintain our standards and update these policies when necessary.

As a member of Waveney Youth F. C. you have an obligation to ensure that the Club upholds these high levels of excellence, to become a member of Waveney Youth F. C. you will be required to sign up to the club's codes of conduct and also the players and parents / spectators charter.

Players

- ✓ Always do my best, even if we're losing or the other team is stronger.
- ✓ Play fairly - I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- ✓ Never be rude to my team-mates, the other team, the referee, spectators or my coach/team manager
- ✓ Do what the referee tells me
- ✓ Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- ✓ Listen to my coach/team manager and respect what he/she says
- ✓ Talk to someone I trust, for example my parents or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

I understand that if I do not follow the code, action may be taken.

Parents / Spectators

- ✓ I will – Remain outside the field of play and behind the designated spectator area (Where Provided).
- ✓ I will – Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.
- ✓ I will – Always respect the match officials decisions.
- ✓ I will – Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- ✓ I will – Remember that children play for FUN!
- ✓ I will – Let the coach(es) do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- ✓ I will – Encourage the players to respect the opposition and match officials.
- ✓ I will - Never criticise a player for making a mistake -mistakes are part of learning.

I understand that breaches of the code may result in action being taken by my County FA and /or The FA.

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Conditions of Membership

I accept that to become a member of Waveney Youth F.C., I agree to abide by the following conditions.

Players Charter

- ✓ I will attend all training sessions and arrive 10 minutes before the scheduled start time.
- ✓ I will attend all games / matches and arrive 30 minutes before the scheduled kick off time.
- ✓ I will notify my team manager if I am not able to attend training or matches.
- ✓ I will not engage in any form of bullying, threatening behaviour or abusive language, towards any person whilst I am representing Waveney Youth F. C. during any Club activities.
- ✓ All kit that I am given by Waveney Youth F.C. i.e. playing kit / jackets, will remain the property of the Club. If I leave the Club I will return all of the kit. Failure to do so may result in compensation being requested and may prevent me from representing any other Club until either the kit has been returned or compensation has been paid.
- ✓ I agree to discharge all outstanding subscriptions / fees to Waveney Youth F.C. accrued during the 2008/2009 season before my membership for the 2009 / 2010 season is allowed.
- ✓ I will support and celebrate the successes of all teams within Waveney Youth F. C.
- ✓ I understand and agree with the Club's policy of player development and I accept that during this process, i may be required to move to another team to give me the best possible opportunities to achieve my playing potential.
- ✓ I accept that I am responsible to pay all fines as a result of any disciplinary action taken against me.
- ✓ I will ensure that my parents / guardian or any other members of my family and supporters will not:
 - Behave inappropriately or use bad language at training sessions or match days, because I will remember their behaviour for a long time and I will get embarrassed.
 - Tell me how to play the game or shout at me when I am playing football on match days, because this confuses me with the instructions given to me by my manager or coach.
 - Berate the match officials and question their decisions, because this behaviour will get my parents and the Club into trouble.
 - Encroach onto the football pitch, because the players could be injured if they run into them.
 - Moan about the decisions that the manager makes, we are a team and he is responsible for the whole team, not just me.
- ✓ I will encourage my parents / guardian to:
 - Take me to the training regularly because I want to be a better player.
 - Get me to the matches 30 minutes before kick off because I need to warm up.
 - Help the manager to put out the goals and put up the nets.
 - Support the team manager with his decisions and not to be upset when I am substituted or I don't start a game.
 - Help me and my team mates by giving encouragement and supporting us, we may not win all our games but we will try very hard and give our best. We want to enjoy our football but this is hard when we are being criticised by our parents.
 - Join in with all the other mums and dads and generate a good team spirit.
 - Congratulate the opposition when we lose or win and uphold the sense of fair play and sportsmanship.

Parents / Spectators Charter

- ✓ I will uphold the good name of Waveney Youth F. C. and will conduct myself in a manner which will not bring the Club or myself into disrepute.
- ✓ I understand that Waveney Youth F. C. will not tolerate any form of inappropriate language or threatening behaviour from parents, supporters, players, officials or Club representatives and I understand that any complaints will be treated seriously and may result in a fine being imposed or suspension / expulsion from the Club.
- ✓ I accept that the playing kit will always remain the property of Waveney Youth F. C. and I understand that if the kit gets damaged / lost, then I will need to pay for a replacement.
- ✓ I will ensure that my son / daughter attend all training sessions and matches (if selected) unless there is a justified reason. I will inform the team manager at the earliest opportunity if my son / daughter can not play / train.
- ✓ I will ensure that my son / daughter will arrive for matches 30 minutes before kick off.
- ✓ I will help the manager on match-days to set up the goals / put up the nets and put them away as appropriate.
- ✓ To ensure the safety of players and officials, I will not encroach onto the field of play.
- ✓ I will set a positive example by applauding good play from both teams.
- ✓ I will respect the managers decision at all times, even if I don't agree with them.
- ✓ I will respect the referees decisions at all times and will not publicly question the referees honesty or integrity

Remember your son / daughter will soon forget a mistake made by a referee during a match, but your son / daughter will always remember your bad behaviour.

If this is your first season with us, you may not be aware that Waveney Youth F. C. is the largest football club in East Anglia and were the proud winners of the 2007 F. A. National Charter Standard Community Club of the year, an award which set the benchmark for other clubs to follow.

This season the club will be fielding an amazing 45 teams, that's over 700 boys, girls and adults running out each week wearing the Gold / Black shirts of Waveney Youth F. C.
