Waveney Youth U11A and opponents Blundeston Magpies played some fine football at Lound on Sunday, but it was the visitors better finishing and defensive abilities which saw them run-out comfortable victors having taken a five-goal lead at the interval.

Waveney took an early lead when Woods' pace and persistence allowed him to burst clear and finish with a fine left-foot shot into the corner. This effort seemed to spur on the Magpies who enjoyed a spell of possession and pressure, but Evans' hard work then set-up Phillips for goal number two for Waveney, following which the floodgates opened. Woods curled a superb left-foot corner straight into the net for the third, before Gallant swept home the fourth as the visitors pass and move total football style became unstoppable. Anderson was then on hand to slam home number five - his first for Waveney 'A' - following a flowing move which pierced the home defence.

Had Waveney's finishing in the second period been as clinical as their first-half strikes, several more goals would have resulted with Gallant, French, Evans, Woods and Lambert all spurning clear opportunities. It was left to Phillips to notch a sixth after sterling work by Evans before Magpies scored a consolation with a fine left-foot finish.

This was another excellent performance by Waveney. All players contributed and a special word should go to the defence who provided a sound platform for the midfield and forwards to create the opportunities and win the match so convincingly.
