Report.

There was a lot of good play from both sides but both defences came out on top to stop any further chances in the first half.

Lewis neat touch and pass found Joe who dribbled past his marker and in to the box and fired in a superb goal bound effort but the keeper was equal to the shot with a fantastic athletic save. Two Waveney defenders left the ball for each other that allowed a Bohs forward to nip in but the shot was saved well by Bradley. With 15 minutes gone Tom whipped in a super corner that Liam SS headed towards goal, the keeper got a finger tip touch on the ball but only managed to divert to Jackson who like a real predator acted quickly to fire in to the net to the joy of the Waveney supporters.

Waveney then had their tails up and dominated until the final minute when a good defence splitting pass allowed the Bohs forward to through but Bradley came out and narrowed the angle and produced a wonderful save to keep Waveney in the game.

5 minutes each way of extra time was played but this could not separate these two great teams so it went to the dreaded penalties. Bohs went first and scored their first 2 along with Waveney, then Bohs missed, Waveney scored their next 2 along with Bohs, this left Lewis
