Report:

With a lot of games either called off or abandoned due to the bad weather conditions, Waveney got sweet revenge for their defeat earlier in the season against local rivals Corton Reserves.

On a slippery pitch with driving rain and blustery winds Waveney always looked the better side. Both teams tried to get the ball down and play football but it was difficult in the conditions. Corton were trying to catch Waveney on the break, but the Waveney back four of Woolston, Sansom, Evans & Griggs played the offside trap very well. Waveney broke the deadlock on 10 minutes when a mix up in the Corton defence left the ball at Tom Aldis feet for him to pass into an open net from 12 yards. The only other clear cut chance of the half fell to Andy Ballard who had his shot well saved by the Corton keeper. The second half saw the pitch get very slippery and it was Corton who nearly scored direct from a freekick but for a great save from Ben Willgoss who turned the shot around the upright. Evans was making some great challenges at the back and seemed to relish playing in the muddy conditions, while Sam & Scarffy controlled the midfield and made the right choice of pass which help create the next to Waveney goals. With 20 minutes remaining Andy Ballard cut in from the right to shoot across the keeper low and hard and into the bottom corner of the net for 2-0. Corton rallied together and worked hard and never gave up but on 85 minutes the game was over after a good passing move found Wells in space on the edge of the box who played a neat ball into Tom Aldis for him to turn and fire home at the near post for 3-0. A big well done goes out to all the players as they have now gone 8 league games undefeated.
