Report.

Waveney entertained travelling Copdock in this first round Tesco Suffolk cup match.

It was the much bigger and more physical Copdock side that had the early pressure and they looked very dangerous on the break. Within 5 minutes Waveney were behind when they failed to close down at a corner. Waveney played in fits and starts but could not get going in the first half, Joe was playing intelligently down the left wing and a superb cross was met by Jordan who just missed the target. Sam put in an excellent cross and Joe blazed over the bar.

Sam was playing hard in the midfield and not only looked to break up the Copdock play but was also looking to get movement from the two wingers, on one occasion he sent a lovely ball through to Joe who beat his man and played the ball to Jordan but the keeper saved his shot. Lewis linked with Liam SS who shot wide and then after a goal mouth scramble the ball bounced to Lewis whose shot went under the keeper to bring the game level. Even this could not get the Waveney side fired up and all too often the ball was played high or aimlessly, even instructions from the sidelines were going un-acknowledged and the players seemed to know best. With 4 players in an offside position Copdock scored with the goal allowed to stand.

Liam SS went on a mazy dribble and crossed to Joe who shot with venom but his shot hit the post. The introduction of Ben finally got Waveney passing and moving in the last 10 minutes of the half. Ben was every where and a super dribble was unlucky when his shot hit the side netting. Jordan had a good shot blocked and he blazed the rebound over the bar. Ben then had an excellent shot which went just over the bar.

With a stern talking to at half time and advise that the best way to beat this strong Copdock side was to play football on the floor. Within a minute of the restart this had paid dividends as Waveney were level when Jordans strong run and shot was parried by the keeper but Ben

Inside 4 minutes Waveney were ahead when a good Tom corner came off a Copdock defender passed the stranded keeper. From that point it was all Waveney but they had to be careful with break aways from Copdock.

Joe then had a goal disallowed followed by a good Ben run who set up Shaun but his pile driver stuck a defender when looking like a certain goal. Joe then jinxed his way through and hit a shot against a post while Ben playing superbly well played a neat ball to Liam SS but he fired into the side netting. A quick George throw sent Jordan galloping through with just the keeper to beat but Jordan finished with style. This knocked the stuffing out of Copdock and they became even more physical.

A Tom pile driver free kick which the keeper had no chance to save killed off the game and resulted in a Copdock player getting a yellow card. Joe had no luck in front of goal and another superb shot hit the cross bar. Waveney had several more chances to increase the lead the best being a good volley just over the bar by Jordan.

At the final whistle the same Copdock player who had been given a yellow card said something to the referee and was then sent off.

Waveney 3 cheered Copdock for their efforts but nothing came back.
