Report:

Waveney continued their title challenge after easing to victory against Brandon. The away side charged out of the blocks, immediately heaping pressure on the Brandon goal. Sam Willgoss was influential in conducting play, utilising the pace and crossing ability of Justin Evans and Tom Aldis. It was the latter who supplied the first goal. Aldis floated his corner towards the run of Daniel Grigg, who beat his marker to head home from twelve yards.

Waveney failed to capitalise on their bright start and as they relaxed somewhat, began to be challenged by the home side's aerial style of play. After a sustained period of pressure, Brandon equalised on the half hour mark through a crisp strike from the edge of the area.

Waveney performed their usual trick of emerging for the second half a much improved outfit and quickly took the game away from their opponents. Aldis got himself on the score sheet in spectacular style as he unleashed a dipping free kick that had the keeper grasping at thin air. The away side were now firmly on top and the third goal followed soon after. After the ball was fizzed goalwards from the right, Paul Hunter was on hand to use a combination of chest and thigh to bundle home.

Following this goal, Waveney were much more assured and any threat that Brandon did possess was efficiently quashed by the back four of Ballard, Beecher, Grigg and Gamble. Renshaw entered the fray to provide Brandon with further problems; and the game was put well and truly beyond doubt with a contender for goal of the season. Another good delivery from Aldis found Hunter in the box; and after hanging in the air, he executed an audacious scissor kick to hammer the ball into the top right hand corner of the net.

Waveney concluded the scoring with Hunter's third of the game. Gamble progressed into the Brandon half and chopped the ball through to the forward; who with only the keeper to beat, slotted home comfortably to complete his hat trick and cap a solid Waveney performance.
