Report:

With three goals in the first fifteen minutes, Waveney effectively killed the game as a contest before it had started. Attleborough were immediately on the back foot, as the home side started off by punishing the visitors with a combination of crisp passing and able running. This was on display as Waveney broke the deadlock after only five minutes. The trio of Gamble, Aldis and Barker combined effortlessly to progress down the right flank; and in setting Aldis free, Barker followed his pass to volley the return ball in at the near post.

The home side were in the ascendency and they soon doubled their lead, this time after good work from the left. Renshaw worked his way to the byline and fired the ball across the face of goal, allowing Barker to beat his marker and score with a diving header. Gamble was a constant threat in overlapping down the right and was to credit for the third. After another foray into the area, the full back won a deserved penalty, which Aldis dispatched to the keeper's right. The first half scoring was concluded shortly before the interval. A set piece from the left was only half cleared and after a goal line melee, Adam Beecher was on hand to prod home.

The second half saw Waveney take their foot of the gas somewhat, whilst always preventing the visitors from getting back into the game. As the home side went through the motions, Attleborough offered little threat to Wilgoss' goal; with the defensive pairing of Beecher and Evans quick to stamp out any chances that the away side did create.

Scarff was busy in the centre of midfield and was instrumental in creating a number of squandered opportunities. However, Waveney's fifth eventually arrived after good work from Littler. The striker produced a typically bustling run past a number opposing defenders, squaring to Aldis to pass the ball into the net. The scoring was completed by Barker for his hat trick. The winger drifted across the box to deflect home a ball from the right; and rounded off a satisfactory performance for the league leaders.
